



FULL BOOK FOR MAKFI

The support from breeders for Makfi has been outstanding and he is now fully booked. Leading breeders such as Cheveley Park, the Aga Khan, Lanwades Stud, Watership Down Stud, Darley, Rathbarry and Newsells will be sending mares, as will many French breeders.

Makfi's owners Qatar Bloodstock will also be supporting their new sire, by Dubawi, with a host of recently acquired top class mares.

These include the dam of Astrophysical Jet, a dual Gr.3 winner by Dubawi; the Gr.2 Cherry Hinton winner Dora Carrington; and Light Step, a Listed winner and dam of the Dubawi two-year-old Listed winner Nova Step. High class two-year-old Baileys Cacao, Gr.2 Sun Chariot winner Danceabout and ultra tough Stakes filly Ripples Maid will also be covered by Makfi.

In addition, Qatar Bloodstock invested in the Green Desert mare Diary for 1,300,000gns at the Tattersalls December Sale. Sold in foal to Galileo, Diary is the dam of Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye winner Total Gallery and Gr.1 Fillies' Mile runner-up Lady Darshaan. She will visit Dubawi in 2011 to replicate the cross that produced Makfi.

REDLAND REAPS REWARDS

The Redland Bloodstock enterprise investment scheme run by Tweenhills continued to reap success at the sales. Their star mare Ripples Maid, in foal to Sea The Stars, realised 240,000gns at the Tattersalls December Sales. She was originally purchased in July 2009 for 132,000gns, and her Bahamian Bounty foal at foot subsequently made 75,000gns in December.

Foals to prove profitable at Tattersalls December Sale in 2010 included a Notnowcato colt out of Cockatrice realising 26,000gns. The syndicate had purchased the dam with the foal in utero for just 11,500gns in December 2009. Also purchased in 2009 was Persian Sea, whose first foal by Royal Applause made 47,000gns and went a long way to recouping the dam's purchase price of 64,000gns.
